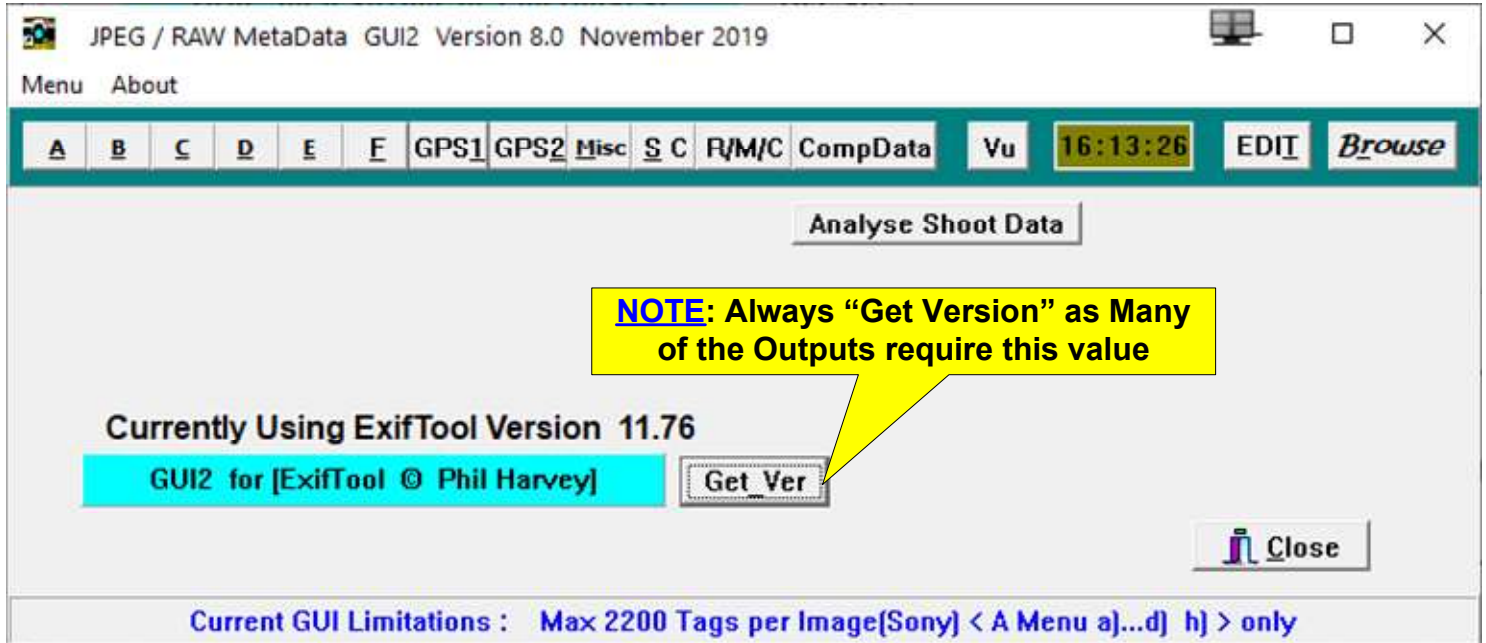

UPDATING to NEW EXIFTOOL Version XX.YY (RECOMMENDED Method)

a) Update to a "NEW version of Exiftool" with **GUI2 Version 8.0** onwards is much simpler now.

b) Download the Windows Executable from the ExifTool home page.
(The file you download will have a name like "exiftool- ###.zip")
(e.g. file you download will have a name like "exiftool-11.77.zip")

c) Extract "exiftool(-k).exe" from the ".zip" file, and place it on your Desktop.

(i.e. Double-click on "exiftool-###.zip" to open the archive,
then drag "exiftool(-k).exe" to your Desktop.)

d) **N.B. RENAME** "exiftool(-k).exe" to "**exiftool.exe**".

e) Move/Copy "exiftool.exe" to your "C:\WINDOWS" Folder (Windows 10)
- Overwrite an older version of exiftool.exe if it exists

You can now Check the "Exiftool Version" from GUI2 Version 8.0 using NEW Button "**Get_Ver**".

a) Update to a "NEW version of Exiftool" with **GUI2 Version 8.0** onwards is much simpler now.
(e.g. My current version of Exiftool is 11.76 with New GUI2 version 8.0)

b) Download the Windows Executable from the ExifTool home page.
(e.g. file I have download is "exiftool-11.77.zip")

c) Extract "exiftool(-k).exe" from the ".zip" file, and place it on your Desktop.

(i.e. Double-click on "exiftool-#.##.zip" to open the archive,
then drag "exiftool(-k).exe" to your Desktop.)

d) **N.B. RENAME** "exiftool(-k).exe" to "**exiftool.exe**"

e) I wish to Save Old version of "exiftool.exe" by going to "Folder C:\windows" and then
by Renaming it to "**exiftool_1176.exe**" (in case it will be next Production version)

f) I now Copy / Move version 11.77 "**exiftool.exe**" from d) above to "Folder C:\Windows".

i) My question is if the next Production version is 11.76 will my Renamed "**exiftool_1176.exe**"
still in "Folder C:\Windows" be the same as what you have now designated ?

ii) If so I can then Rename **exiftool_1176.exe** back again to "**exiftool.exe**" to use .
